Sunday June 11th - Music in New Malden, with John Irving (Piano) and Ursula Monberg (Horn), Virtuoso works by Schubert and Czerny

Sunday 18th June: Rev Steve Wild will be taking the morning service, and the mosaic made by the church organisations will be blessed and unveiled. This will be followed by a buffet lunch as members and invited guests reminisce together.

June 18th to July 13th - Fish Spotting. New Malden will be invaded by fish of various shapes and sizes. They are hiding around the town in shops between Elm Road and Shannon Corner and all along the High Street to the Triangle. How many can you find?

Sunday 25th June: There will be a church Family picnic in Beverley Park after the morning service led by Stan Brown. Bring your own picnic, and meet by the swings ready for events such as family rounders etc. The races and fun start at 2pm.

Saturday 1st July: Hymnathon - after the Malden Parade. Come and sing! 150 different hymns, just pop in and join in for as long as you wish.

Saturday 1st – Saturday 15th July: A prayer net will be outside the front of the church where you are invited to tie a piece of yarn as a symbol of a prayer. This net will be part of the service on Sunday 16th July.

Sunday 2nd July 6.30pm: Cafe Church including an interview with one of our longstanding members with her memories of the church.

Friday 7th July 10am - Saturday 8th July 4.00pm: Exhibition 'The church in the High Street -150 Years' Refreshments 10-4pm, including light lunches.
