## **CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY NEW MALDEN & KINGSTON DEBT CENTRE - TWO PAID PART-TIME VACANCIES**

We currently have vacancies for a Debt Centre Manager and a Debt Coach. The Centre Manager would be expected to work for 16 hours per week (four sessions of four hours, at least two sessions in normal office hours); the coach would be expected to work for 8 hours per week (two four-hour sessions; at least one in normal office hours).
