**SUNDAY MORNING SERVICES:** There is a crèche area at the back of the church where a member of our crèche team will welcome families with babies & young children (not manned for family services and school holidays). Toys and books are available. Pushchairs can be left in the vestibule / entrance. If your child is fractious, don't worry, but if you need to take time out, you can follow the service on the screen in the vestibule/entrance lobby.

**HOLY COMMUNION** is generally celebrated on the first Sunday of every month in the morning service and the second Sunday in the evenings. It is the privilege of all Christians to be able to meet with God in an act of communion - when Christ sets the table and bids us

**CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP:** The service has a small music band and singing leaders, using modern praise songs, with overhead projection in a joyful upbeat style.

**FAMILY SERVICES:** The service is in a style for the whole family, at which children and young people stay in Church with their family for the duration of service.

**TEAS & COFFEE & SOFT DRINKS:** These are served in the coffee bar after the morning services.

**KOREAN SERVICES:** These are Korean language services. Please contact Rev Paul Han for further information.

**SUNDAY EVENINGS SERVICES:** Are held in the parlour, it is a quieter style of worship with greater opportunity for reflection and contemplation.

**SPECIAL SERVICES:** These are as shown on the plan and may be held at different times from usual.

**CIRCUIT SERVICES:** These are generally evening services and are held once a quarter, at one of the four churches in the circuit.
